

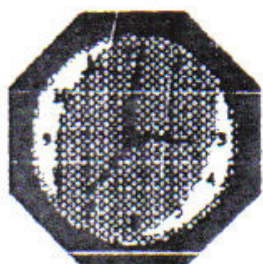
THE RESURRECTION
